## The Sun River Electric Annual Golf Scramble

Plans are underway for the 13th Annual SREC Golf Scramble. The four-person scramble will be held at the Harvest Hills Golf Course in Fairfield on Saturday, July 30th. The cost per person will be \$50 again this year. If you are interested in being a Hole Sponsor, the cost is \$150.

Sun River Electric had the very first golf scramble in the summer of 1999. The purpose was to earn money to give to community projects in our service area.
