Apple Roll-ups

1/3 C butter
1/3 C water
1 1/3 C sugar, divided
2 pkgs. refrigerated
crescents rolls
3 C finely chopped peeled
tart apples
1 tsp. cinnamon

In a saucepan combine butter, water, and 1 cup sugar; cook over medium heat until butter is melted and sugar is dissolved. Set aside. Unroll crescent roll dough into a rectangle, seal seams and perforations. Combine apples, cinnamon, and remaining sugar, sprinkle over dough within 1 inch of edges. Roll up starting with the long side. Cut into 1 inch rolls. Place on a greased 9x13 inch pan. Pour the syrup over the rolls. Bake at 350 degrees for 20 minutes. Serve warm.
